This is N. Railway Avenue E about 10 years after the 11 Nov 1898 fire. Only Revere House, on the west end of the block, survived. Imagine the rest of the buildings on the block every one of them on fire! The Queen's Hotel (in the location of the Palace) was built of
 stone but the roof caught and the building was gutted.
The same thing had happened one block west 10 years earlier; in that fire no building on that block was spared.
1888... 1898... And still, downtown Deloraine is not done with devastating fires. There were more fires to come!
