Mental Health First Aid

BY THE DELORAINE-WINCHESTER HISTORICAL SOCIETY

About 10 miles north of Deloraine on Highway 21, just beyond the Deloraine-Winchester boundary, you perhaps have noticed a small sign and cemetery perched on a knoll on the east side of the road – Chain Lakes Cemetery. In the fall of 1899, this was the location of a newly built meeting place for The Society of Friends, aka Quakers. (Quakers attend 'meeting' rather than church services.) In 1925 the congregation merged with one at Lauder and the building became Dand Union Church, then Dand United Church. The building was moved to Dand proper in 1949 and continued to serve the community until closing in 2005.

A lady from Winnipeg purchased the building and was excited to camp out in Dand. That is, until the mice came out to play as she lay in her sleeping bag! That was the end of her adventure and the building sat empty for several more years. It was purchased by Corrie and Jock Van der Westhuizen a few years ago and in 2020 the church was on the move again ~ it rolled past its first home on the knoll and was settled on the west side of Chain Lakes where it has been lovingly and beautifully converted to Life House ~ a transition home for people in recovery and available for meetings & gatherings when no one is in residence. Soon to celebrate it's 124th birthday, the former little church on the prairie is set for its next one hundred years.

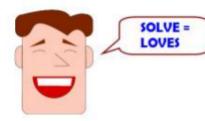

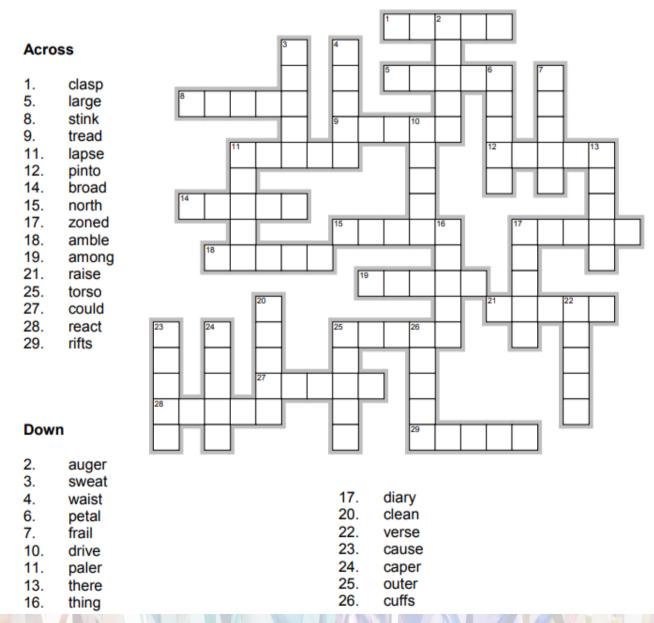




5-letter Anagram Crossword Puzzle

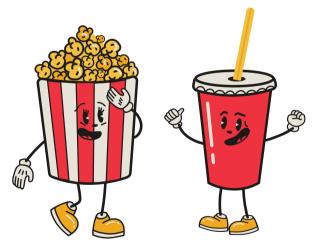
