"Jakob the Liar" is a novel by Jurek Becker that explores the life of Jakob Heym, a Jewish man in a ghetto during World War II. He spreads false rumors to inspire hope and laughter among the residents. As he fabricates stories about the Red Army, he also conceals a young girl named Lina, who escaped from a camp. Despite the dangers, Jakob continues to tell his tales, believing they will uplift the spirits of those around him. He faces increasing suspicion and danger from the German authorities, leading to a moral dilemma about the balance between hope and deception

Sept 25: Victor/Victoria starring Julie Andrews (PG)

Victoria Grant (Dame Julie Andrews) is a poverty-stricken soprano trying to find work in Paris in the 1930s. With the help of a worldly-wise nightclub singer, she invents her alter-ego Victor, a female impersonator who is hired to sing at a fashionable night spot.




